

MORAGA-ORINDA FIRE DISTRICT

The Moraga - Orinda Fire District (MOFD) is one of six county fire districts in Contra Costa County and serves the Town of Moraga, City of Orinda, Canyon and other unincorporated areas of Contra Costa County.

The District, formed in 1997, covers 47 square miles and supports a population of approximately 42,000. While reporting to a five-member board, the Fire Chief oversees five fire stations, a budget of \$18 million and a staff of 74 employees, 15 reserve firefighters and 10 volunteer reserve communications personnel. Services include emergency operations, fire prevention and public education, support services, personnel and finance.

FIRE CHIEF

The new Chief will have two or more years of command and administrative experience at the Battalion Chief level or higher, along with a broad knowledge of fire services, emergency management and expertise in emergency medical services. A Bachelor's degree is required – and those in Business Administration or Public Administration are desirable. An MA/MS degree is preferred, and completion of the National Fire Academy Executive Officer program and a California Chief Officer Certification are highly desirable. Salary is expected to be approximately \$185,000 annually, DOQ.
